

## Resolution

A meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Govt. Degree College Sugh- Bhatoli was held on 31st of October 2022 with Officiating Principal Shashi Bhushan in the chair to chalk out the course of action to be followed in the academic session 2022-23. The following proposals were unanimously adopted:







- (i) It was decided to enhance the quality of teaching-learning in the college by making every possible step. To give more exposure to the students, it was decided to hold class room tests, seminars and group discussion. Steps will be taken to make education more experimental, holistic, integrated, inquiry-driven, discovery oriented, learner-centred, discussion based, flexible and enjoyable. To give practical experience to the students, industry visits will be arranged.
- (ii) Various awareness campaigns like HIV/AIDS awareness, Road Safety awareness, Cyber Security awareness, Awareness against Drug addiction, Gender Sensitization, Safe Drinking, Swachhta Abhiyan etc. shall be observed in a big way.
- (iii) It was decided to hold special classes for the students who are weak in studies.
- (iv) More stress to be laid on the personal hygiene of the students. Menstrual hygiene of the girl students shall be taken care of by providing facility of napkin vending machine in girl's common room and incinerator in girl's toilets. Repair work in the students and staff toilets to be taken care of as and when needed.
- (v) In order to provide clean, potable water to the students water tanks to be cleaned from time to time.
- (vi) Sign boards displaying important awareness messages to be fixed at vantage points at the college campus and in the periphery of the village Sugh-Bhatoli.
- (vii) NSS unit of the college shall be made more versatile so that students learn the lesson of social service which can be beneficial for the society in future. Tree plantation drive shall be taken up as part of our commitment to save the environment.
- (viii) In order to guide the students regarding various career options, **Career Counseling and Guidance Cell** shall be made functional.


(ix) Faculty members will be persuaded to attend Refreshers and Orientation Programmes. To enhance their research skill, they will be persuaded to attend national and international seminars/workshops etc.

(x) Libraries are a source of information containing materials such as books, documents, media, etc. that is easily accessible for use and not just for display. Library plays a paramount significant role in improving the quality of education in an institution. Efforts will be made to strengthen library with quality books of different subjects and books based on Indian Knowledge System. Magazines pertaining to competitive exams will be subscribed.

(xi) National Education Policy 2020 is going to be implemented from the session 2023-24 in the State, therefore, keeping in view the exigency of the situation preconditions to implement NEP will be fulfilled. Multidisciplinary approach, Multiple Bank of Credits and Multiple Entry and Exit are important recommendations of NEP 2020 which are to be introduced from session 2023-24. Efforts shall be made to follow guidelines of higher authority to make all possible arrangements to implement NEP2020. Students as well as staff members will be persuaded to join online course through SWAYAM MOOCS. College website will be made functional with more dynamic features. College plans to install CCTV cameras at important points in the coming sessions.

(xii) As a flagship Quality Assurance Agency of India, National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) has taken several initiatives to reach out to the Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) for improvement of quality and sustenance. In this connection College plans to apply for Provisional Accreditation in the coming sessions.
